





Procedure Individual Licence (PIL) Refresher Workshop

A personal licence shows you are qualified and suitably experienced to carry out authorised regulated procedures, under supervision if necessary. PILs must comply with the terms and conditions of their licence and are expected to fully understand the requirements of the project licence they are working under.

Continuing professional development (CPD) is an important activity for all licence holders and they should review their training and supervision needs regularly with their NTCO, as a minimum every five years but generally more frequently.

This half-day workshop utilises exercises involving case studies for an interactive approach to refresh and update knowledge, emphasises the importance of the PIL Standard Conditions and how to comply with them, and ensures licence holders are aware of common licence non-compliances and how they are to be avoided.






